

Modals = způsobová slovesa

*Modální sloveso **must** nemá tvar minulého ani budoucího času, používá se forma **have to**. Sloveso **can** má v minulém čase tvar **could**, ale budoucí tvar nemá. Používá se opis **be able to** (= být schopen). Pro vyjádření smět/nesmět existuje také opis **be allowed to** (= mít dovoleno).*
